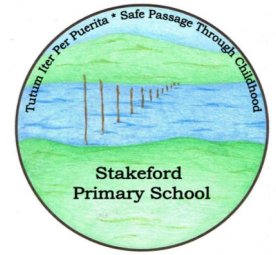




Stakeford Primary School

Welcome Back



We would all like to extended a warm welcome back to all our pupils and families . The children looked so smart in their new uniforms and have settled back into school routines very quickly. Your child will bring home their class **Welcome Pack** today which include general information about school and the curriculum for the year ahead . There will also be a timetable so that you know when they have PE.

They will also bring home an **E.Safety Acceptable Use Proforma (Years 1-6 only)**: All schools are required to have pupils sign an Acceptable Use Proforma (AUP) which is their agreement to the school's rules regarding using the internet and ICT resources. And potential consequences for breaking those rules. Please read the AUP with your child and return the signed copy to school by **Wednesday 11th September**. Children who do not sign will have limited access under special arrangements.

Reminders

School dinners are free to children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Nursery and Key Stage 2 pupils are charged £11.00 per week (£2.20 per day). Dinner money should be paid to the **class teacher** on a Monday. Menus can be viewed on the school website. We would also like to remind parents that any change from dinners to packed lunches, and vice versa, needs to be at least a week in advance.

Contact details must be up to date. If any details have changed, such as addresses, telephone and mobile numbers or emergency contacts please inform the school office immediately so that we can update our records.

School Uniform is now ordered online direct from the company at www.totstoteams.com. School only hold a small stock for those parents with no internet connectivity.

Punctuality -Last year late arrivals after 9:00 am had a huge impact on the work we did in school, primarily interrupting the work already underway in the classes. This year all children arriving after 9:00 am will need to be brought to the office by an adult who will be asked to sign a late registration form. On this form you will be asked for a reason for the lateness. Parents of pupils who repeatedly arrive late will be invited to a meeting with Mrs Hall where the reasons for lateness will inform discussions for a plan to improve punctuality.
