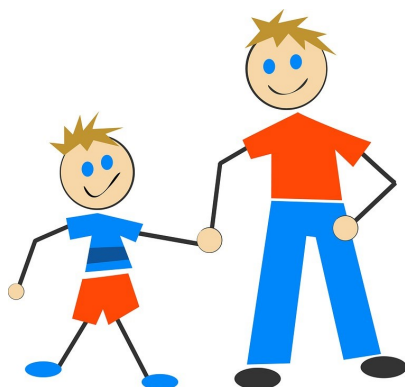
## Polite Request
