Welcome Back

We would like to extend a warm welcome back to all of our pupils, parents and carers. After a long summer break, we have had a great start to the new school year.

We will be sending out important documents today so please check your emails and your child's bag.

- **The contact details checking exercise is vital.** We need to ensure that we hold up to date information for you and your child, including address, key contacts and **allergy information**. These will be sent out in paper form and **MUST** be returned for every child. If your child has any allergies, we will be contacting you to create an Individual Allergy Action Plan, as part of Benedict's Law, which came into force for school's this week.
- **Permissions** need to be reviewed every year. A link to a google form will be emailed out to you. Again, this **MUST** be completed for every child, As part of this form, parents will also be asked to sign the Home/School Agreements and the Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) for computing.
- **Class Welcome Packs** will be emailed by your child's class teacher next week with important information about the timetable and the curriculum.

Breakfast and After School Clubs will start again on Monday. All bookings must be made in advance on the school money app. This still applies to Breakfast Club even though it is now free, due to the limited number of spaces initially. Breakfast Club will now be in the school hall.

Can Early Years parents not enter the EYFS yards before 8:30 am and please do not let your children play with the equipment before or after school.

We are a 'No Mobile Phone Zone'. Children in Years 5 and 6 who walk to and from school alone and need a phone for safeguarding reasons, must hand it in, turned off, on arrival. Children in younger year groups who are moving between parent homes must leave phones and all other electronic devices in the school office for safety. Apple watches or any watch that can access the internet are also not allowed.
